They will be here accepting orders before and after the concert.

<u>Mitten Tree:</u> The spirit of giving is a big part of the Christmas season. This year we will be once again having a "Mitten Tree" in our lobby. Children are invited to donate a pair of mittens to those less fortunate. The mittens will hang on the tree until December 15th, at which time they will be donated to a local charity.

Dressing for the Weather: As you have noticed for the past week or so, we are really experiencing colder temperatures and snowy conditions. <u>*Kiss and Go Program:*</u> The <u>Kiss and Go</u> program is a volunteer program with the goal of increasing student safety while simultaneously increasing the efficiency in which traffic comes on and off the

parking lot. Parent volunteers approach the car doors and open the doors to help the students out of the cars. The volunteers will help the students out of the vehicle if needed. The idea is for the parent to give the child their kisses and hugs while they are in the line waiting to reach the drop off spot. This way the line moves very quickly. The system is the safest and quickest when the student, if only one, sits on the right

hand side of the vehicle so the student is dropped off on the designated walking area and does not have to cross the traffic. New volunteers are always welcome! We ask that cars not park in the school lot as this increases the safety risk for our students with moving vehicles around them. Thanks for keeping student safety a priority!
